The Build

Things usually took a little longer than were planned and some things couldn't be done the way the students wanted them to be. Although, the students came together well, got through their problems and completed the Go-Kart with no time to spare. The students are no doubt proud of their work and now have the skills to do similar or more complex projects. This was a great experience for them.

The Parts

All the parts for this project were obtained separately by the students themselves. In some cases it was quite easy, where the students would just go to a shop in either Wekelit El Belah, Harefein, or Eisbid Shelaby and find the pieces they needed ready made, but in other times it was more difficult and time consuming. For parts like the Axel, brake caliper and brake disk, the students had to go somewhere to get them fabricated. This took a lot of time but in the end made the car come out great. WESC supplied all the steel for the chassis at a cheap price which helped the students a lot with their budget.

With all the parts obtained the students remained below budget which was quite surprising. Parts like the engine and batteries cost a lot of money and at some points the students wondered if they even had enough money to complete the build. But in the end, everything worked out and with all the parts obtained the students still had cash to spare.
